WWTF | Key facts

w|w|T|F

- Founded in 2002; funding activities since 2003: more than 265 m € have been awarded (Banking Foundation, City of Vienna)
- WWTF Mission:
 - We fund top scientific research in Vienna
 - We provide substantial funding for larger research projects and international research group leaders coming to Vienna
 - ▶ We run competitive calls according to highest international standards

VRG | About the program (I)

- The program addresses Vienna-based universities and research institutions that intend to hire an excellent young researcher from abroad for setting-up and managing an independent research group.
- ➤ The prospective host institution in Vienna must provide a **clear-cut career plan**, i.e. steps leading to a tenured position (e.g. "Qualifizierungsvereinbarung")
- Typically, the first "genuinely independent" group led by a young researcher.
- ➤ The WWTF funding (6-8 years) should enable the group members to take the next step in their career.

VRG | About the program (II)



Vienna Research Group leaders...

- assume leadership responsibility for group member
- are independent in designing their research work and recruiting staff
- apply for additional third-party funding over the years
- come from abroad to Vienna: (i) no current employment contract with an Austrian institution three months before the submission deadline until the submission deadline, (ii) being employed at a foreign research institution for at least two years in the last three years counting from the submission deadline
- are up to 8 years after PhD (care duties may extend this period), counting from the submission deadline

VRG | About the program (III)




There are two phases in the funding period (6-8 years):

- (i) first phase mainly financed by WWTF (4-5 years)
- (ii) an interim evaluation after the first phase (preferably co-organized by WWTF and the host institution)
- (iii) increased in-kind contributions of the home institution in the second phase (i.e. years 6, 6-7 or 6-8)

VRG24 | Key facts

- ➤ 15th call within Vienna Research Groups for Young Investigators Programme
- > 2024: up to 3 positions with max. funding of € 1.6 million each
- Proposal deadline: 2 pm CET, March 19th 2024

VRG24 | Scope

- ► The call is issued within the field of Information and Communication Technology
- ► The proposed field of research should
 - advance theory and methods in Artificial Intelligence/Machine Learning
 - ► traverse research disciplines (e.g. Medicine, Environmental Sciences, Physics, Social Sciences and Humanities, etc...) and demonstrate an interdisciplinary work with data and knowledge in its broader scope

VRG24 | Process

- ► The call process comprises
 - the submission of a concise research proposal
 - followed by a hearing of selected candidates between mid September to beginning of October 2024 (we will announce the final date as soon as possible)
- Obligatory job advertisement (by host institution) e.g. in a high impact journal that is relevant for the topic and/or via professional societies/mailing lists
- WWTF especially encourages Vienna-based research institutions to propose female group leaders
 - ➤ Successful appointment of a woman → financial benefit for the Vienna host institution to support their gender mainstreaming activities

VRG24 | Finances

- The financial emphasis should lie on the funding of scientific personnel
 → should be balanced in relation to infrastructure/material costs
- ▶ In-kind vs. overhead: Basic infrastructure such as office equipment, rent, telephone, internet, basic lab equipment does NOT count as in-kind but is covered by the overheads (covered by WWTF)!
- ➤ The budget allocations with eventual partner institutions must already be specified at the application stage
- ► WWTF does **not** cover **any travel expenses** for candidates who are invited to the hearings (candidates will most likely be invited to participate online)

WWTF | Gender Equality Strategy & Plan (I)



WWTF aims to:

- play an active role in closing the gender gap in science and research
- further improve processes and conditions to increase the proportion of female scientists, their resources and career opportunities
- avoid bias in the assessment and evaluation process



WWTF | Gender Equality Strategy & Plan (II)



- Evaluation criteria that account for career breaks
 & atypical career paths (e.g. care duties), as well
 as gender dimension in research
- WWTF encourages balanced teams & more female researchers to apply as PIs of research projects (including financial incentive for universities)
- Childcare and / or career coaching costs for female funded personnel may be included to a small extent
- Gender aspects in the proposal: Guidance is given in the call specifications (checklist, p. 9)



WWTF | Open Science Policy



WWTF aims to:

- fund research guided by principle "as open as possible, as closed as necessary"
- provide funds related to the cost of OA publication and data management
- place more emphasis on Open Data by adoption of FAIR principles



- About 6-7 excellent international scientists/experts with call-relevant expertise
- Duties within the process
 - Selecting proposals to be reviewed
 - Nominating reviewers
 - Inviting candidates to the hearing
 - Evaluating the performance at the hearing
 - Comparing assessments and formulating the funding recommendation

Applicants

- Universities and research institutions in Vienna (via a "proponent")
- Suggestion of
 - excellent young researchers from abroad who fall within the scope of the eligibility criteria
- Active search for female researches highly welcome and encouraged

Submission

- Submission via WWTF new Funding Portal
- Have a look at → Submission Guideline
- No funding of private companies
 - Self funded business partners are possible and welcome
 - Project relevant services from companies can be calculated as consumables (if these services can not be provided within the projects with reasonable effort)

Formal eligibility check

- Conducted by WWTF office
- Timely submission of proposal
- Submission must include all relevant signatures = Proponent,
 Host Institution, Group Leader (not on one page)
- In-kind contribution: >20% of total sum
- Overhead costs: the regulations of the host institutions must be observed
- Compliance with the academic age limit
- From abroad (criteria in call specifications)
- Active promotion by universities and research institutes (eg. mailing lists,...)

Review process

- Proposals that lie outside the subject area as well as those that do not meet quality standards are not recommended for the review process by the jury
- Unsuccessful applicants will be briefly informed
- In case proposals are admitted to the review process: reservation of both hearing days **absolutely necessary** (if hearing is in Vienna: booking of a flexible ticket)

Peer review process

- 2-4 written reviews per proposal will be obtained
- Reviews only by international peers; remain anonymous
- Review reports form the basis of the jury's discussion for the invitation to the hearing as well as the funding decision after the hearing

Decision

- Formal decision by WWTF boards
- All applicants receive a decision letter (acceptances and rejections) with anonymised reviews via e-mail

Employment contract

- The employment contract must be made available to WWTF no later than two months after the decision of the WWTF board of directors
 - Clarification until when a qualification agreement will be offered
 - Agreement on a coordinated evaluation of the candidate between the host institution and WWTF
 - If the employment contract cannot be achieved within two months, the funding will be offered to a reserve candidate

Funding contract

- Funding contract between WWTF and the host institution of the VRG leader (§ 27 according to UG2002 for universities)
- VRG leader has scientific and financial responsibility

 - Short annual electronic reports to WWTF via Funding Portal as prerequisite for payment installments
 - Site visit by WWTF
- After project completion:
 - Comprehensive final report



- We aim to expand the system's features in due course. Please be patient if problems arise with the new system! Make sure to use the "Report a Bug" button in case you encounter one.




WWTF Funding Portal | General information (II)



- Complete PDF containing all information is generated automatically after submission
- ➤ Signature sheet can be downloaded at any time ("Overview" must be inserted). Signatures do not have to be all on one sheet! Max of 3 pages can be uploaded, digital signatures possible.
- ➤ For signatures, please follow your institutional policies / ask the research service







Things to consider for your proposal



- Check the scope of the call
- ► Read the guidelines → Evaluation criteria (Call Specifications, page 6-7)
- Don't assume highly specific expertise of our Jury, especially in the first selection round
- Polish your CV, use the right template provided by us
- Pay more than lip service to gender equality & open science

- Work programme: one single PDF file upload (maximum 8 pages). Please adhere to the format specifications provided in the template!
 - the state of the art in the proposed field and scientific challenges in the next years
 - 2) the research plan
- Potential ethical aspects
- Open science statement (check WWTF Open Science Policy)
- Disclosure of other applications for funding
- Relevant references (maximum 20; 10 most relevant references)

Proposal | Integration of VRG leader (I)



- - VRG candidate selection process at future host institution, including gender mainstreaming measures
 - Advertisement procedures
 - The international publication of a job announcement and/or distribution via mailing lists/professional societies is obligatory (upload only one!)
 - Status and career advancement steps of the group leader during the funding period
 - Please explain in detail the steps leading to a tenure position (e.g. the exact process of reaching a "Qualifizierungsvereinbarung" including time frames). These details will form the foundation of contractual elaborations in the case of funding

Proposal | Integration of VRG leader (II)



- ➤ Interim evaluation process of the Group Leader (preferably co-organised by WWTF and host institution)
- Career perspectives of the Group Leader after the funding period
- Integration of the Group Leader

Proposal | Budget (I)



- - Calculation tables (personnel costs, non-personnel costs, budget per region, cost overview): everything in whole numbers, e.g. EUR 780,000, everything in €
 - Description of the envisioned group
 - Description of the equipment and consumables
 - Statement of the monetary and in-kind contributions
 - Please be aware that the cash and in-kind contributions are just the contributions from the host institution
 - WWTF Overhead policy: max. 20% of the fundable direct costs

Proposal | Budget (II)



- - ➤ Please avoid short term employments! Minimum wage according to the "Kollektivvertrag" (collective agreement) or following the standards of the Austrian Science Fund FWF
 - Attention: Wage for "Studentische Mitarbeiter*in" is calculated by FWF for 20 hours and a "DoktorandIn" for 30 hours per week
 - ➤ Wages above "Kollektivvertrag" are possible and must be described. No additional wages for people who are already 100% employed. An increase of employment up to 100% through WWTF funding is possible
 - Total funding applied for will automatically be calculated including a 6% annual salary increase
